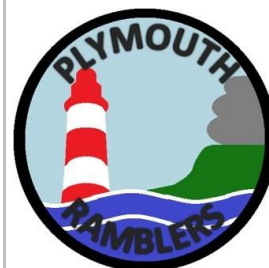

Group walks and events

February 2022



Wed 2 February 2022 09:30 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Moderate

Cumston track and River Avon

Starts at 09:30: Shipley Bridge CP (fee £4 unenforceable) (TQ10 9EL, SX680629)

From CP at Shipley Bridge walk up to the reservoir then to the Cumston Track taking in Grippers Hill, Pupers Hill, Snowdon, Rider's Hill, Huntington Hill and Warren and back along the Avon. Taking in many interesting scheduled monuments along the way including Heap of Sinners. We also pass GR 666 666! Expect boggy ground at times. NOTE 09:30 START

Wed 2 February 2022 10:30 - 6 miles/9.7 km - Moderate

Around Cardinham Woods

Starts at 10:30: Cardinham Woods CP (PL30 4AL, SX100667)

From the car park (cashless pay and display), we will be on forest tracks and then fields to the village of Cardinham. Return to the woods via lanes and footpaths. Along the way we will see an historic church, the remains of a Norman castle and an unusual mine chimney. Optional refreshments at Woods Cafe, just by the car park, at end of walk.

Sun 6 February 2022 10:30 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate

Penn Beacon and Rook

Starts at 10:30: outside Cornwood Inn (PL21 9PY, SX605597)

Cornwood, Wisdome, Dendles, up to Penn Beacon and back via Parkland and Rook, passing through a variety of Dartmoor terrains, with lots of archaeological interest and dramatic views. There are several stream crossings, not difficult as long as your boots are waterproof! Parking available in pub carpark or roadside.

Wed 9 February 2022 09:20 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Strenuous **Liskeard to Looe**

Starts at 09:20: Liskeard train station (PL14 4EF, SX247636)

A varied landscape with fantastic views and plenty of rainforest-like valley walking. Mud probable, plus clambering through neglected woodland and the odd steep climb. Some road walking on narrow quiet lanes. We will catch the 8.40 train from Plymouth and then walk from the station under the mainline railway viaduct before climbing up the hill to cross the railway on a footbridge. There is one train and one bus per hour to get us back to Liskeard at the end. NB If you drive there is a fee for station parking.

Wed 9 February 2022 10:15 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate

Penlee Point with only some coast path

Starts at 10:15: Cremyll (PL10 1HU, SX452533)

Past Empacombe, up to Maker Church, high route to Kingsand/Cawsand, Coast Path to Penlee. Back via the nature reserve, the beach for geology and pilchard palaces, up into the Park to see the Stone Seat. Cremyll Ferry at 9.45.

Sat 12 February 2022 10:30 - 4 miles/6.4 km - Leisurely

aRound oReston and Radford

Starts at 10:30: Kings Arms, The Quay, Oreston (PL9 7NE, SX500534)

From the start point (free roadside parking) we will walk to Hooe Lake, Radford Woods, Park and Lake and then the old railway track to the roundabout. Then pick up the SWCP on Breakwater Road and back to The Quay. Optional lunch at the Kings Arms at end of walk.

Sun 13 February 2022 10:00 - 9 miles/14.5 km - Moderate

Fowey circuit

Starts at 10:00: Bodinnick CP (PL23 1LY, SX130524)

Bodinnick Ferry to Fowey. Saint's Way to Polridmouth and coast path back to Fowey. Ferry to Polruan and footpath around Pont Pill back to Bodinnick.

Sun 13 February 2022 10:30 - 6 miles/9.7 km - Leisurely

Railway and farms

Starts at 10:30: Lowery Cross CP (PL20 6PD, SX547692)

A leisurely walk including Yennadon Down, Leather Tor farm, Stanlake farm and the disused railway to Princetown

Wed 16 February 2022 10:00 - 12 miles/19.3 km - Strenuous

Hurston Ridge, Hameldown and Shapley Tor

Starts at 10:00: Shapley Common viewpoint CP (TQ13 8RL, SX698834)

Varied terrain of footpath and open moorland, with some interesting prehistoric sites along the route. Includes a tough uphill stretch in the middle.

Wed 16 February 2022 11:05 - 6 miles/9.7 km - Moderate

River Tamar woods, valleys, quays and mines

Starts at 11:05: Calstock Quay (PL18 9QR, SX436685)

Train ride to Calstock (10.28 from Plymouth) or meet up at Calstock Quay (11.05) for a longer version of my recent Family Walk. Circular trek taking in Cotehele Quay and woods, Danescombe Valley and looping back above Calstock, down to Okel Tor mine and Nature Reserve and along the river back to the Quay and station. Ups and downs through some potentially muddy woodland paths!

Sun 20 February 2022 10:00 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate

Down the pipe

Starts at 10:00: Cadover Bridge main CP (PL7 5EH, SX554644)

Cadover Bridge, Shaugh Bridge, Clearbrook, Dewerstone and moor

Sun 20 February 2022 10:00 - 10 miles/16.1 km - Moderate **A**

rough tour

Starts at 10:00: Two Bridges CP (PL20 6SR, SX609750)

A tour of several Tors, over moorland, and can be WET moorland in parts.

Wed 23 February 2022 10:00 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Leisurely

Brixton circular

Starts at 10:00: Haye Rd CP (PL9 8AR, SX532536)

Circular walk, mainly fields and woodlands

Wed 23 February 2022 10:00 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Moderate

The beautiful Erme

Starts at 10:00: Station Road, by viaduct (PL21 0US, SX636569)

We follow the Erme up to the edge of Piles Copse, expect mud and stream crossings. Steep climb up Sharp Tor, returning via Butterdown Hill.

Sun 27 February 2022 10:00 - 10 miles/16.1 km - Moderate

Up and Down

Starts at 10:00: Hound Tor CP (TQ13 9XG, SX739792)

From Hound Tor car park along to Jay's grave, Natsworthy, Grimspound and then down to Widdecombe before returning to Hound Tor car park.

Sun 27 February 2022 10:00 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Moderate

Shell Top and Penn Beacon

Starts at 10:00: Cadover boat pond CP (PL7 5JA, SX570631)

A meander to Shell Top and Penn Beacon with stunning views if the weather is kind to us.

There will be uphill climbs but we will not rush them.
