Wed 1 June 2022 09:30 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Strenuous

Challenge Steng-a-Tor

Starts at 09:30: CP behind Dartmoor Inn Lydford (EX20 4AZ, SX524853)

Carshare 08:30 at George Park & Ride

Typical North Dartmoor walk, military track and open moorland with challenging ground. Good views visiting Kitty Tor, Great Links Tor and a few in between.

Wed 1 June 2022 10:00 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Leisurely Drake's Trail

Starts at 10:00: Leg O'Mutton CP (PL20 6AA, SX517679)

Leisurely stroll from Yelverton to Tavistock, returning by bus. Meet at free CP over the cattle grid at Leg O'Mutton. (For public transport option, take no 1 bus at 9:07 from Royal Parade, arriving 9:46.)

Sun 5 June 2022 10:00 - 10 miles/16.1 km - Moderate

Moorland fringe from Brent Tor

Starts at 10:00: Brent Tor CP (PL19 ONP, SX468805)

Fields and woods to edge of Lydford via Langstone Manor and Wastor Farm. Return below Gibbet Hill to N. Brentor and S. Brentor. Optional climb to the church for the views.

Wed 8 June 2022 10:30 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Moderate

The 5 Woods Way

Starts at 10:30: Honicknowle Lane entrance to Ham Woods Nature Reserve (PL2 3RF, SX471579)

From the start point (a very small free car park with alternative roadside parking available nearby), we will link five of Plymouth's woods: Ham, King's Tamerton, Budshead, Woodland and Honicknowle, walking on footpaths, lanes and pavements. Brooks, creeks, a lake and a river to see along the way, plus an historic church, the ruins of a manor house and the site of two old mills. Optional refreshments at Ace Snacks in Burrington Way, situated near the end of the walk.

Thu 9 June 2022 19:00 - 3 miles/4.8 km - Leisurely

Forder and Trematon

Starts at 19:00: St Stephens Church roadside (PL12 4NL, SX418584)

Start at St Stephens Church, then Antony passage, vineyards (sorry no wine!), Trematon Castle. Finishing at Cecil Arms.

Sun 12 June 2022 10:00 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Strenuous

Widcombe wandering

Starts at 10:00: Widcombe CP (fee) (TQ13 7TA, SX719768)

Widcombe, Bonehill, Moorhay, West Combe, Grimspound and Hameldown. Some very steep climbing. Spectacular views on a fine day. Grade is moderate/strenuous.

Sun 12 June 2022 10:00 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate

Norsworthy to Nun's Cross

Starts at 10:00: Norsworthy Bridge CP (PL20 6PE, SX568693)

Carshare 09:20 at George Park & Ride

A classic moorland route with some gradual ascents and perhaps some boggy bits. Down Tor, Nun's Cross, Hart Tor and Raddick Plantation, with good views throughout.

Wed 15 June 2022 10:00 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Moderate

Meet the leat

Starts at 10:00: Lowery Cross CP (PL20 6PD, SX547692)

Lowery Cross, Sharpitor, leat to quarry and back over Yennadon Down

Wed 15 June 2022 10:00 - 10 miles/16.1 km - Moderate

A clifftop walk to Arthur's Castle

Starts at 10:00: Pennycrocker Farm Campsite (PL35 0BY, SX125926)

Carshare 08:30 at Tesco Transit Way

A clifftop walk from north of Boscastle to Tintagel and return by bus with plenty of natural beauty to view in between. Lots of things to see en route and a few hills to climb. Catch 15:55 bus back. Bus passes required. Parking £5/vehicle if not staying overnight. Possibility to stay overnight at the meeting point, Lower Pennycrocker Campsite (£10/person/night). Please advise if you are attending and wish to stay over.

Thu 16 June 2022 19:00 - 4 miles/6.4 km - Leisurely

Hooe and SWCP

Starts at 19:00: Morley Arms CP, Billacombe Rd (PL9 7JD, SX502541)

Morley Arms, Pomphlett, Radford Lake, Hooe Lake, SWCP and return to Morley Arms for refreshments. All welcome

Sat 18 June 2022 10:30 - 3 miles/4.8 km - Leisurely

One chapel, one grotto, two beaches, Rame Head Family Walk

Starts at 10:30: Rame Head CP (PL10 1LH, SX420487)

From Rame Head CP, optional climb up to the chapel then along the coastpath to Queen Adelaide's grotto and Penlee point for picnic lunch. Continuing on to Cawsand for icecream and beach play before hopping on and off the bus for final bit of coastpath back to Rame. 3/3.5miles walking with plenty of climbing/exploring and splashing!

Walking along the Teign river

Starts at 09:30: Court Street CP Moretonhampstead (TQ13 8WQ, SX752860)

Challenging walk with three good climbs, starting from Court Street carpark Moretonhampstead or nearby street if you are lucky, via Mardon Down, Clifford and Fingle Bridges, Castle Drogo (bring your NT Cards), Dogmarsh Bridge, then up towards Cranbrook Castle and back to start

Sun 26 June 2022 10:00 - 10 miles/16.1 km - Strenuous

Bowerman Nose Best

Starts at 10:00: Swallerton Gate CP (TQ13 9XG, SX739792)

Carshare 09:00 at Coypool Park & Ride

From the CP we head towards Bowermans Nose before descending to the River Bovey via Water and Becky Falls. A tough climb then takes us to Lustleigh Cleave and a lovely ridge walk out to Hunters Tor. We descend once more to Foxworthy and back to the CP via Manaton and hopefully the cake shop.

Ermington amble

Starts at 10:00: Filham Park free CP, Ivybridge (PL21 0LE, SX643552)

Carshare 09:30 at Coypool Park & Ride

A walk through the rolling South Hams countryside featuring lanes, woodland, farmland, parkland, villages and riverside.

Wed 29 June 2022 09:30 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Moderate

Grimspound and Coombedown

Starts at 09:30: Bennetts Cross CP (PL20 6TA, SX679815)

Carshare 08:30 at George Park & Ride

A lovely diverse walk that takes in both moorland and woodland. Dogs on leads are welcome, there are some styles but they are mainly dog friendly. Parking is at Bennetts Cross car park which isn't that big but there is another car park a little before that if it is full.

Thu 30 June 2022 19:00 - 4 miles/6.4 km - Leisurely

Wembury wander

Starts at 19:00: Barton Close (PL9 0LF, SX527494) A walk through woods, coast path and fields.
