Sun 1 May 2022 10:00 - 10 miles/16.1 km - Moderate

Dartmoor Way Festival walk 10

Starts at 10:00: Leg O'Mutton CP (PL20 6AA, SX517679)

Dartmoor Way to Clearbrook, Goodameavy, Dewerstone Cottage, Shaugh Bridge and Cadover

Bridge. Return to Yelverton via moorland, lanes and paths. Good views of the Rivers Plym and Meavy and fine distant moorland vistas. This is a Dartmoor Way Festival walk - please book on 07835 188239 or at festival@dartmoorway.co.uk.

Sun 1 May 2022 10:30 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate

Dartmoor Way Festival walk 11

Starts at 10:30: Leg O'Mutton CP (PL20 6AA, SX517679)

Dual use path from Yelverton to Drake's Viaduct, then down to Grenofen Bridge and alongside the River Walkham towards Double Waters. Ascend West Down and follow a quiet lane into Tavistock and along by the canal. Return by bus (fare or bus pass). Wed 4 May 2022 09:30 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Moderate

New Bridge to Corndon

Carshare 08:40: Coypool Park and Ride (PL7 4FB, SX521567)

Starts at 09:30: Newbridge CP Pay (TQ13 7NT, SX711708)

A varied walk with some wonderful views, hopefully, taking in Spitchwick, Poundsworthy, Jordan then up to Corndon Down and return along Dr Blackall's Drive. A couple of steep climbs before lunch. Note early start time

Wed 4 May 2022 10:45 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Moderate

Rame circular

Starts at 10:45: Admirals Hard (PL1 3RA, SX462540)

Circular walk to Kingsand and Cawsand, with one long flight of steps and one long steep climb. Leisurely pace.

Carshare Admirals Hard at 10:30 in order to catch the 10:45 ferry (£2, cash or card). Public transport recommended as car parking is difficult.

Sun 8 May 2022 10:00 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate

Sharp Tor, Bodmin Moor

Starts at 10:00: Tokenbury Corner, Pensilva (PL14 5PJ, SX281698)

Varied walk mostly over moorland and disused tramways. Iconic Cheesewring, standing stones, Caradon Mast and Sharp Tor. Amazing views, weather permitting. Classed as "moderate" as some boulder scrambling!

Wed 11 May 2022 09:30 - 14 miles/22.5 km - Strenuous

2 Old & 1 New Fortifications

Starts at 09:30: Court Street, Moretonhampstead (TQ13 8LG, SX751860)

Lovely walk with views via Mardon Down, Wooston fort, Fingle Bridge, Castle Drogo, Fingle Bridge again, Cranbrook fort and return to MH. Some steep climbs and stiles. Either park in CP (£3.80 all day) or nearby road if you feel lucky.

Wed 11 May 2022 10:30 - 6 miles/9.7 km - Moderate

Up the Plym

Starts at 10:30: Coypool Park & Ride (PL7 4TB, SX521568)

Up the Plym on either side via tramways, quarries, leats etc. Carshare 10.30 in the furthest corner of the P&R.

Sat 14 May 2022 10:30 - 3 miles/4.8 km - Leisurely

Maker Church to beaches family walk

Starts at 10:30: Maker Church CP (PL10 1JB, SX447520)

From Maker Church CP across the estate to the Red Seat to explore garden terraces. Then along the coast path to Sandways beach for picnic lunch and beach play before returning via a different beach to Maker church. Possible extension to Kingsand for ice cream! Please book with numbers of children.

Sun 15 May 2022 10:00 - 9 miles/14.5 km - Moderate

Burrator bluebells

Starts at 10:00: Burrator quarry (PL20 6PH, SX549676)

Around Sheepstor, through the bluebell woods to Meavy and back.

Wed 18 May 2022 09:30 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Strenuous

Fur Tor at last

Starts at 09:30: Postbridge main CP (£2) (PL20 6SY, SX652792)

Typical moorland walk with steep climbs, tussocks and good views and not a stroll in the park

Thu 19 May 2022 19:00 - 4 miles/6.4 km - Leisurely

Burrator bimble

Starts at 19:00: Burrator Quarry CP (PL20 6PW, SX549677) A leisurely stroll in

Burrator area to start our evening programme.

Sun 22 May 2022 10:40 - 6 miles/9.7 km - Leisurely

Along the Fowey

Starts at 10:40: Bodmin Parkway (PL30 4RA, SX109640)

A linear walk from Bodmin to Lostwithiel along the beautiful Fowey valley. Catch 10:01 train from Plymouth or meet 10:40 at Bodmin Parkway station. Walk via Lanhydrock and Restormel castle to Lostwithiel and return by train. Plymouth to Lostwithiel return is currently £6.90 with discount card. Meet at 9:45 on Plymouth station concourse if you want to band together for group ticket.

Wed 25 May 2022 09:30 - 12 miles/19.3 km - Strenuous

Tamar trek

Starts at 09:30: Bere Alston (recycling point) (PL20 7AX, SX448668)

Quiet roads and pathways to Bere Ferrers, following the river Tamar up to the opposite side of Calstock, pathways back to Bere Alston.

Wed 25 May 2022 10:00 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Moderate

Crazy Well Pool and Cuckoo Rocks

Starts at 10:00: Norsworthy Bridge Car Park (PL20 6PF, SX563682)

Circular walk from Norsworthy Bridge to Crazy Well Pool and Cuckoo Rocks via Devonport Leat and Hingston Hill stone row.

Finding the start of your walk

Start and meeting points include nearest postcode and an Ordnance Survey grid reference accurate to 100m. Use postcodes with care: in rural areas the nearest postcode may be some distance from the actual start point. See OS maps for an explanation of how to use grid references.
