Wed 3 November 2021 10:00 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Moderate

Visiting Stephen and Peter again (for Val)

Starts at 10:00: Pork Hill CP (PL19 9LQ, SX531751)

Pork Hill to Peter Tavy. Some stream crossing and two steep climbs

Sat 6 November 2021 11:00 - 3 miles/4.8 km - Easy

Leats, bridges and waterfalls family walk

Starts at 11:00: Norsworthy Bridge (PL20 6PF, SX568693)

From Norsworthy Bridge to Leathertor Bridge and farm ruins, then along Devonport Leat to the aqueduct and Black Tor Falls and back by a different path. Picnic lunch en route. Lots to explore and water, water everywhere! Please book with numbers and ages of children to help with route planning.

Sun 7 November 2021 10:00 - 12 miles/19.3 km - Moderate

Wembury wander

Starts at 10:00: Wembury NT CP (£3 for non-members) (PL19 9LZ, SX518784)

From Wembury NT carpark back to Bovisand. Up through the valley and across fields to Hollacombe. Then along Cofflete Creek and via Wembury House to Warren Point and back along the cliff path to Wembury

Sun 7 November 2021 10:30 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Leisurely

Elburton to Brixton circular

Starts at 10:30: Haye Rd CP (PL9 8AR, SX532536)

Elburton to Brixton and back via River Yealm woods. Easy walk.

Wed 10 November 2021 10:00 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Moderate

Yealmpton circular

Starts at 10:00: New Road Yealmpton (PL8 2FB, SX579516)

Fields, lanes and tracks to Ermington, through the Flete Estate to join the Plym-Erme trail to Dunstone, then to Creber and back through Torr to Yealmpton

Wed 10 November 2021 10:30 - 5 miles/8 km - Leisurely

Conchies Road

Starts at 10:30: Princetown CP (£2) (PL20 6QJ, SX589734)

A leisurely walk around Princetown touching on some of the prison history. From the slopes of North Hessary Tor, we visit Soldiers' Pond, Conchies Road and Tor Royal, finishing up at Fox Tor cafe. Mainly moorland tracks with relatively little ascent, but could be boggy in places.

Sat 13 November 2021 10:30 - 4 miles/6.4 km - Leisurely

Brixton and Yealm

Starts at 10:30: Elliots Hill Brixton (PL8 2AG, SX552519)

A leisurely walk on footpaths and fields passing alongside the river. A few stiles and ups and downs.

Sun 14 November 2021 10:00 - 12 miles/19.3 km - Moderate

Harper's footsteps

Starts at 10:00: Jewson's yard at end of main W Looe CP (PL13 2HR, SX248537)

This was one of John Harper's popular walks and we do it today in his memory as he passed away in September this year aged 90. From CP walk to Polperro via Watergate, Catherine Park Wood and Pelynt. After lunch return on coast path through Talland Bay, Tencreek and Kilminorth. Some steep climbs though most of walk is moderate.

Wed 17 November 2021 09:30 - 12 miles/19.3 km - Strenuous

Two pools, one waterfall and a leat

Starts at 09:30: Princetown CP (£2) (PL20 6QQ, SX590734)

Up to North Hessary tor, on to Foggintor quarry and Black Tor falls and then along Devonport Leat to Crazywell pool. We then follow the leat back to Bachelor Hall and finally the Fox Tor cafe. Note: 9.30am start Contact: Olwen K,

Wed 17 November 2021 11:00 - 5 miles/8 km - Moderate

Around Kit Hill

Starts at 11:00: Kit Hill CP at main entrance (PL17 8HS, SX383713)

A meandering walk that takes in the main points of interest on Kit Hill, rambling up and down to see the quarry and inclined plane, stacks and adits, with wide-ranging views over the Cornish countryside. The CP is on Kit Hill Road about half a mile after the Louis Tea Rooms, which we can visit for optional tea on our return. Note later start time.

Sat 20 November 2021 10:30 - 4 miles/6.4 km - Leisurely

Strolling around St Budeaux

Starts at 10:30: Tamar Bridge CP, Pemros Road (PL5 1LP, SX438586)

We meet in the Tamar Bridge car park. Free parking for a maximum 4 hours. On street parking also available in Pemros Road and Normandy Way. Walk through Kinterbury Creek L.N.R., Blackie Woods, and Saltash Passage. Many different views of the Tamar to be seen. A mixture of paths, woodland tracks, which will be slippery in wet conditions, and some pavements. Optional lunch at the Ferry House Inn, near to end of walk.

Sun 21 November 2021 10:00 - 10 miles/16.1 km - Moderate

Bolt Head

Starts at 10:00: Malborough Village Hall CP (TQ7 3BU, SX710398)

Popular coastal walk to include Salcombe Estuary and Bolt Head

Wed 24 November 2021 10:00 - 10 miles/16.1 km - Strenuous

Hi Quintin Man

Starts at 10:00: Postbridge main CP (£2) (PL20 6TH, SX647789)

A proper moors walk from Postbridge visiting Grey Wethers stone circle, Sittaford Tor, Quintin Man, Stat's House, waterfall, with some challenging ground and two steepish climbs with great views

Wed 24 November 2021 10:30 - 6 miles/9.7 km - Leisurely

Plymbridge to Boringdon

Starts at 10:30: Plymbridge (PL6 8AW, SX523587)

Meet under the railway bridge at Plymbridge, having parked either side of the actual river bridge. Follow the old canal to Cann Quarry. Pick up an upper leat and then forest tracks to Boringdon Camp picnic area. Back along by the Lee Moor tramway. Lots of industrial archaeology. Well sheltered; little mud for once.

Sun 28 November 2021 10:30 - 6 miles/9.7 km - Moderate

Wembury east

Starts at 10:30: Barton Close CP Wembury (PL9 0LF, SX527494)

Down to the coast path and along to the beach. Return up via valley and fields. A few stiles and probably mud. The walk involves ascents and descents along the coastpath and through fields and lanes. Long trousers advisable.
