

Plymouth Ramblers Walks List Sept 2021



There is no longer any limit on numbers nor any need to book, unless this is explicitly stated in the walk description.

Wed 1 September 2021 10:00 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Leisurely

Roborough ramble

Starts at 10:00: First CP on right after Dartmoor Diner (PL6 7BH, SX506638)

Walk to Yelverton following Drake's Leat and return across Roborough Down. Some good views on a fine day.

Wed 1 September 2021 10:00 - 14 miles/22.5 km - Strenuous

Memorial walk 2015

Starts at 10:00: Okehampton railway station (EX20 1EL, SX594945)

This walk was done in September 2015 in memory of Martin Robins and was led by Peter Major. The walk starts from Okehampton railway station, up through the East Okement river and on to open moorland. We will be visiting numerous tors including Oke Tor, High Willhays and Yes Tor, and Rowtor target railway, and returning back through Okehampton battle camp. A strenuous walk with great views on a clear day and an ascent of over 2038 ft.

Sun 5 September 2021 10:30 - 10 miles/16.1 km - Moderate

Stroll across the moor

Starts at 10:30: Access road to Prewley Water Work (EX20 4HR, SX544910)

Paths and tracks on open moorland (paths faint in places), short stretch of minor road, tarmac-surfaced Granite Way (shared with cyclists). Parking is off A386, signed Granite Way, over cattle grid, with several parking areas at the side of the track (please park towards the top of the lane before the gates).

Wed 8 September 2021 10:00 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate

Around South Brent

Starts at 10:00: South Brent Station or if full Station approach (TQ10 9BB, SX698602)

South Brent to Shipley Bridge, Diamond Lane and Owley Moor Gate.

Wed 8 September 2021 10:00 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Moderate

Postbridge circuit

Starts at 10:00: Postbridge CP (PL20 6TH, SX646788)

11 mile circuit from Postbridge

Sat 11 September 2021 10:30 - 4 miles/6.4 km - Leisurely

Down, rail and leat

Starts at 10:30: Lowery Cross CP (PL20 6PD, SX547692)

A short walk with easy gradients across Yennadon down, Devonport leat and disused railway.

Sun 12 September 2021 10:00 - 12 miles/19.3 km - Moderate

Beesands coastal

Starts at 10:00: Beesands CP (TQ7 2EL, SX820405)

Popular coastal walk with challenging features. Coast path through Start Point to Prawle. Steep climb to East Prawle then paths and lanes back to coast. Stunning views.

Sun 12 September 2021 10:00 - 7 miles/11.3 km - Moderate
Visit Stephen and Peter
Starts at 10:00: Pork Hill CP (PL19 9LQ, SX531752)
Pork Hill to Peter Tavy. Some stream crossing and one steep climb

Wed 15 September 2021 10:00 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate
A Wander around Yealmpton
Starts at 10:00: New Road, Yealmpton (PL8 2JF, SX580516)
From Yealmpton to Worston Weir. Lanes and tracks to Lotherton Bridge and back to Yealmpton through Torr

Wed 15 September 2021 10:30 - 9 miles/14.5 km - Moderate
North coast circuit
Starts at 10:30: Pentireglaze NT CP (PL27 6QY, SW941799)
Mainly coast and field paths via Pentire Head, The Rumps, Lundy Hole and Port Quin. Leisurely paced walk with time for a dip, refreshments available in car park.

Wed 22 September 2021 10:00 - 12 miles/19.3 km - Strenuous
Farms, ancient monument and tors
Starts at 10:00: Postbridge CP (PL20 6TH, SX646788)
Starting from Postbridge main car park visiting Pizwell farm, Grimspound, Hookney Tor, King's Oven, Sheepfold. Mostly open moors with a few tracks. With great views on a clear day

Wed 22 September 2021 10:30 - 6 miles/9.7 km - Moderate
Rame Head/Coast Path circular
Starts at 10:30: Penlee Battery Nature Reserve CP (PL10 1LB, SX436491)
Through Penlee Nature reserve down to coast and along to Rame Head with optional climb to chapel. Continuing on the coastpath then inland loop through lanes and fields to Cawsand and back to Penlee Point and starting point. Familiar territory but still a favourite coastal walk.

Sat 25 September 2021 10:43 - 4 miles/6.4 km - Easy
Bodmin train, Lanhydrock and rivers family walk
Starts at 10:43: Plymouth railway station (PL4 6AB, SX476552)
10.43 train from Plymouth (Devonport/St Bud/Saltash) to Bodmin Parkway. Circular walk through woods, Lanhydrock Estate and along the river for train home at 16.29. Picnics, playgrounds and paddles along the way! Please book in with numbers of adults and children. Groupsave on train fare possible.

Sun 26 September 2021 10:00 - 12 miles/19.3 km - Moderate
Kingsbridge to Frogmore and back
Starts at 10:00: Kingsbridge College, West Alvington (TQ7 1HB, SX729438)
A varied walk starting in West Alvington. Walking through Kingsbridge and then over fields and footpaths to Frogmore. Along Frogmore Creek and back to West Alvington.

Sun 26 September 2021 10:00 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate
Cawsand circular
Starts at 10:00: Admiral's Hard (Plymouth) (PL1 3RL, SX462539)
After catching the 10.15 ferry from Admiral's Hard (Plymouth) we will leave from Cremyll at 10.30 following a largely inland route via Maker Church to Cawsand. After lunch we return along the coastal path back to Cremyll.

Wed 29 September 2021 10:00 - 11 miles/17.7 km - Strenuous

A bleak place

Meet at 09:00: Towerfield Drive (PL6 7FG, SX504617)

Starts at 10:00: Access road to Prewley Water Works (EX20 4HP, SX545910)

Moorland walk linking Great Links and a bleak place, moderate to strenuous.

Wed 29 September 2021 11:15 - 8 miles/12.9 km - Moderate

Along the Tamar

Starts at 11:15: Gunnislake station (PL18 9ED, SX427708)

Catch 10:27 train to Gunnislake, or meet at 11:15 at station. From there we take country lanes to Chilsworthy, then head down to the river to follow the Tamar Valley Discovery Trail to Calstock station, where you can catch a return train to Plymouth or back to Gunnislake.
